**Where** refers to a **place** in English. For example: **Where** is my hat?

**Were** is the **past tense** of the verb **to be**.

For example: We **were** on holiday last week.

**Wear** is part of the verb **to wear**.

For example: **I wear** my jeans.

## Mathematical Vocabulary

**Number bond** – 2 or more numbers that are added to equal a total

This week's mathematical point ...

### Number bonds to 10

Number bonds to 10 are really important facts to learn as they help us with lots of calculations. These are number facts where the answer totals 10.

<u>Number bonds to 10</u>	
0	10 = 10
1	9 = 10
2	8 = 10
3	7 = 10
4	6 = 10
5	5 = 10
6	4 = 10
7	3 = 10
8	2 = 10
9	1 = 10
10	0 = 10

Once we know these facts, we can relate them to lots of other calculations by using the units to help us calculate mentally.

$$2 + 8 = 10$$

$$20 + 80 = 100$$

$$2 + 8 = 10$$

$$12 + 8 = 20$$

$$2 + 8 = 10$$

$$32 + 18 = 40$$
