Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.

Begin to use a capital letter to start a sentence and a full stop at the end.

Read and understand simple sentences.

Offer explanations for why things might happen, making use of recently introduced vocabulary from stories, non-fiction, rhymes and poems when appropriate.

Children will explore literacy through role play, phonics, the writing area and story time.

Physical

Developing ball skills. Rolling and tracking a ball, throwing with accuracy, kicking a ball and dribbling with hands and feet.
