Curriculum Map - Spring Term 2024 Year 4 - Blue and Green

Daily reading, learning of times tables and practicing of spellings is strongly recommended. Please use Times Tables Rock Stars to practice. Spellings will be sent out weekly.

Maths

Children will be studying fractions
this term. They will learn to:

- Multiplying by 0 & 1
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts up to 12 x 12.
- Multiply more than two numbers.
- Divide 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number.
- To recognise and use tenths and hundredths.
- To find equivalent fractions.
- To simplify fractions.
- To recognise and use fractions greater than 1.

Science

For the first half term, we will be focusing on animals including humans. We will begin by looking at the digestive system and then move on to look teeth of humans and other animals.

During the second half term, we will be focussing on different materials. We will be exploring the differences between solids, liquids and gases and looking at how substances can change state through melting, freezing, condensation and evaporation.

History

We will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons: who they were; how they settled in Britain; some of their famous kings.

Geography

We will be learning about mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes and the impact they have on the geography of the world as well as humans.
