Stories from an unfamiliar setting - We will be looking at a range of stories from settings we are unfamiliar with. We will look at the stories features, structure and then we will write our own stories.

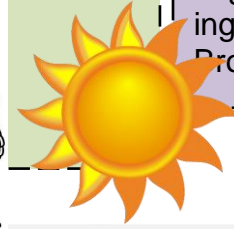
